## MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE HILL COUNTY WATER DISTRICT

The regular meeting of the Hill County Water District was held on December 6, 2017 at the District's shop/office at Hingham, Montana.

**RECOGNITION OF VISITORS**: Tina Wood of Joplin, Montana.

## **CALL TO ORDER:**

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by President Dave Jones, who acted as Chairman. All board members were present and the chairman declared a quorum present. Also present was Manager Scott Decker and Secretary Tammy Pike.

<u>PUBLIC COMMENTS</u>: No other members of the public were present or made any comments.

## **APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM PREVIOUS MEETINGS:**

The Chairman asked for corrections or additions to the minutes of the October 25, 2017 regular board meeting previously received by all board members. On motion by Rob Moog, seconded by Dan Hybner, the Board approved the minutes of the October 25, 2017 regular board meeting.

#### **OLD BUSINESS:**

None.

#### **OTHER OLD BUSINESS:**

BILLING: Tammy Pike advised the Board on looking into other payment options for the Districts customers. Ms. Pike contacted Roy Borgman of Heartland Billing Solutions and Pat Azbil of BDS Interface. Mr. Borgman can add credit card payment options to the Districts website and will also provide a toll free number for customers to call to make a payment. Heartland will charge a 4% convenience fee to the customer and the District would not incur a set-up fee or monthly fee. Ms. Pike also contacted Shelly Holloway of Rural Water Impact to inquire on fees associated with updating the website to include the bill payment option. Ms. Holloway does not charge for adding links to the website or any other changes to the website.

Ms. Azbil can add credit card payment options through Black Mountain Software which the District currently uses for billing. BDS will charge a one-time fee of \$850 and a monthly maintenance fee of \$75. BDS will also charge a 3.5% convenience fee to the customer. Other fee based options can also be added to the package. Black Mountain Software would also have a setup fee to interface its program with BDS.

Since Heartland Billing Solutions fees were minimal, Ms. Pike contacted Mr. Borgman and had the credit card payment option added to the Districts website. Customers can now visit the Districts website <a href="www.hillcountywaterdistrict.com">www.hillcountywaterdistrict.com</a> and pay their bill by clicking on the Bill Payment icon. Customers will need to know their account number which is located on their bill. Customers can also pay their bill by credit card over the phone by calling (877)299-2815.

## **NEW BUSINESS:**

<u>EMPLOYEE REPORTS</u>: Scott Decker reported on sending the Total Coliform sample site proposal to Libby Henrikson of DEQ. Mr. Decker also reported on sending an email to Greg Butts of DEQ.

Mr. Decker advised the Board that we are right at 100,000,000 gallons to date. By the end of the year Mr. Decker anticipates the District will have pumped approximately 104,000,000 gallons which is an increase of 24% from the previous year.

Mr. Decker reported that the control board for the ATS for the generator at BPS #1 failed. A new board has been installed and another board has been ordered for inventory.

Mr. Decker advised the Board EC Power will be sending a service tech to inspect both generators sometime this month.

Mr. Decker also advised the Board the costs for the UV bulbs and quartz sleeves will increase in January. Mr. Decker ordered extra bulbs and sleeves for the 2018 maintenance before the fee increase is implemented.

Mr. Decker reported the meter reading equipment will need to be updated to windows 10 and the handheld reader will also need to be upgraded. Mr. Decker proposed purchasing a reader similar to the one used to read branch lines. The Board discussed the matter and on motion by Lowell Strissel, seconded by Kevin Springer, the Board approved upgrading the meter reading equipment and purchasing a new reader similar to the one used to read branch lines.

Mr. Decker advised the Board the storage tanks will need to be cleaned and inspected in 2018 and will need to be added to the 2018 budget.

Mr. Decker also advised the Board he is doing research on replacing the pumps in Inverness and Hingham with vertical multi stage pumps and is waiting for information from Northwest Pipe.

<u>FINANCIAL REPORT</u>: Tammy Pike referred the Board to the engagement letter from Anderson Zurmuehlen provided with the meeting materials. The letter needs to be reviewed and executed prior to the release of the audit. The board reviewed the letter and on motion by Rob Moog, seconded by Dan Hybner, the Board approved the engagement letter and authorized the president to execute the letter.

PROPOSED ORDINANCE 2017-1: The Board reviewed and discussed the second and final reading of Ordinance 2017-1 amending Section 1.7 pertaining to schools and apartments. No changes were made and Ordinance 2017-1 and on motion by Kevin Springer, seconded by Rob Moog the Board approved Ordinance 2017-1 and authorized execution of the Ordinance. A copy of said Ordinance is appended to the minutes.

#### **OTHER NEW BUSINESS:**

<u>BOARD ELECTIONS</u>: Tammy Pike referred the Board to the letter from Susan Armstrong regarding 2018 elections. Terms for Lowell Strissel, Dan Hybner and Kevin Springer are up for appointment.

<u>BOARD VACANCY</u>: The Board discussed having Tina Wood fill the vacant position on the board for the remainder of the term. Discussion was held with Tina Wood and on motion by Rob Moog, seconded by Dan Hybner, the Board approved Tina Wood filling the vacant position on the board for the remainder of the term and advised Tammy Pike to send a letter to the Liberty County Commissioners to have Ms. Wood appointed for the remainder of the term.

#### A RESOLUTION CALLING FOR A TRUSTEE ELECTION

WHEREAS, Section 7-13-2231, MCA, requires that the trustees of a Water & Sewer District are to be elected and can only be appointed if no nominations are made for the office of trustee; and

WHEREAS, Section 13-2-502, MCA, requires candidates for the office trustee of a Water & Sewer District to file a Declaration of Nomination and Oath of Candidacy at least 85 days before the election; and

WHEREAS, the election may not be held earlier than 85 days after the date of the order or resolution calling for the election pursuant to 13-1-504, MCA; and

WHEREAS, 13-1-504, MCA, requires the governing body to specify in the order or resolution calling for the election whether the election is to be conducted by mail or by polling place; and

WHEREAS, the trustees of the Hill County Water District have determined that 3 trustee terms will expire in May, 2018, and

WHEREAS, the trustees of the Hill County Water District find that it is necessary to elect 3 trustees at the election om 2018.

#### NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

- 1. A trustee election for the Hill County Water District to elect 3 trustees shall be held on May 8, 2018.
- 2. The District requests that the election be conducted by Mail Ballot.
- 3. Declarations for Nomination and Oaths of Candidacy for candidates for trustee may be filed with the Hill County Clerk & Recorders/Elections Office no later than 5:00 p.m. February 12, 2018. If, after the write-in candidate filing deadline of March 5, 2018, the number of candidates is equal to or less than the number of positions to be elected, the election administrator shall cancel the election. The District's governing body shall declare elected by acclamation each candidate who filed for a position. If a nomination is not made for one or more trustee positions, the District's governing body shall appoint one or more trustees as necessary to fil those positions.

#### ORDINANCE NO. 2017-1

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 1.7 OF THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE HILL COUNTY WATER DISTRICT PERTAINING TO CHARGES TO SCHOOL DWELLING UNITS, APARTMENT BUILDINGS AND APARTMENT COMPLEXES

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Directors of the Hill County Water District that the following sections shall be amended:

Section 1.7 of the Rules and Regulations of the Hill County Water District is hereby amended to read as follows:

1.7 CHARGES TO SCHOOL DWELLING UNITS, APARTMENT BUILDINGS AND APARTMENT COMPLEXES.

Schools that operate buildings with dwelling units shall be charged for each dwelling unit separately.

Apartment buildings or apartment complexes shall be charged for each dwelling unit separately.

A dwelling unit shall be defined as a structure or the part of a structure that is used as a home, residence, or sleeping place by a person who maintains a household or by two or more persons who maintain a common household, pursuant to 70-24-103, MCA.
