MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE HILL COUNTY WATER DISTRICT

The regular meeting of the Hill County Water District was held on October 25, 2017 at the District's shop/office at Hingham, Montana.

RECOGNITION OF VISITORS: No visitors were present.

CALL TO ORDER:

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by President Dave Jones, who acted as Chairman. All board members were present and the chairman declared a quorum present. Also present was Manager Scott Decker and Secretary Tammy Pike.

The Board had a moment of silence in remembrance of Larry Olson.

<u>PUBLIC COMMENTS</u>: No other members of the public were present or made any comments.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM PREVIOUS MEETINGS:

The Chairman asked for corrections or additions to the minutes of the October 4, 2017 regular board meeting previously received by all board members. On motion by Lowell Strissel, seconded by Dan Hybner, the Board approved the minutes of the October 4, 2017 regular board meeting.

OLD BUSINESS:

<u>UGRIN ALEXANDER ZADICK, P.C.</u>: Tammy Pike referred the Board to the letter from Roger Witt regarding representation. The Board reviewed the letter and accepted the terms set forth in the letter. Dave Jones executed a confirmation letter to Mr. Witt regarding representation.

OTHER OLD BUSINESS:

NEW BUSINESS:

<u>EMPLOYEE REPORTS</u>: Scott Decker reported the recent snow storm knocked down power lines at the Fresno Pumpstation. A pole outside the building with the meter loop had to be repaired as it was damaged when it fell.

Mr. Decker advised the Board on ordering three chlorine colorimeters which will be used for chlorine monitoring on the three bigger branch lines. It is the District's understanding the lines will need to monitor a detectable trace for chlorine.

Mr. Decker referred the Board to the coliform sample reduction proposal letter to DEQ that was included with meeting materials. Mr. Decker discussed the current coliform sample plan and how the District, under the combined distribution system, will be required to take additional samples. Mr. Decker is also proposing the number of monthly samples be reduced.

Mr. Decker advised the Board that he and Tammy Pike will set up a meeting with the District's

attorney to discuss the District changing to a combined distribution system and ordinances related to the change.

<u>PERSONNEL COMMITTEE</u>: Larry Fossen reported on the committee's meeting to review the evaluations for employees. The committee recommended rehiring Scott Decker, Tammy Pike and Lonnie Cady with an hourly wage increase of \$.80 for Scott Decker and an hourly wage increase of \$.50 for Tammy Pike and Lonnie Cady, effective as of the November 2017 pay period. On motion by Larry Fossen, seconded by Rob Moog, the Board approved rehiring Scott Decker, Tammy Pike and Lonnie Cady with an hourly wage increase of \$.80 for Scott Decker and an hourly wage increase of \$.50 for Tammy Pike and Lonnie Cady, effective as of the November 2017 pay period.

<u>PROPOSED ORDINANCE 2017-1</u>: The Board reviewed and discussed the first reading of Ordinance 2017-1 amending Section 1.7 pertaining to schools and apartments. No changes were made and Ordinance 2017-1 will be reviewed for its second reading at the next regular board meeting.

OTHER NEW BUSINESS:

<u>BOARD VACANCY</u>: The Board discussed filling the Liberty County appointee position on the board formerly held by the late Larry Olson. The Board discussed the process and perspective candidates to fill the position. Perspective candidates will be contacted and the Board will discuss the matter further at the next regular board meeting.

ORDINANCE NO. 2017-1

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 1.7 OF THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE HILL COUNTY WATER DISTRICT PERTAINING TO CHARGES TO SCHOOL DWELLING UNITS, APARTMENT BUILDINGS AND APARTMENT COMPLEXES

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Directors of the Hill County Water District that the following sections shall be amended:

Section 1.7 of the Rules and Regulations of the Hill County Water District is hereby amended to read as follows:

1.7 CHARGES TO SCHOOL DWELLING UNITS, APARTMENT BUILDINGS AND APARTMENT COMPLEXES.

Schools that operate buildings with dwelling units shall be charged for each dwelling unit separately.

Apartment buildings or apartment complexes shall be charged for each dwelling unit separately.

A dwelling unit shall be defined as a structure or the part of a structure that is used as a home, residence, or sleeping place by a person who maintains a household or by two or more persons who maintain a common household, pursuant to 70-24-103, MCA.
