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MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE HILL COUNTY WATER DISTRICT

The regular meeting of the Hill County Water District was held on May 1, 2024, at the District's office at Hingham, Montana.

RECOGNITION OF VISITORS: No visitors were present.

CALL TO ORDER:

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by President Lowell Strissel, who acted as Chairman. All board members were present and the chairman declared a quorum present. Also present was Manager Chad Hedges and Secretary Tammy Pike.

MIKE LIPP/DILLON LIPP: Without objection, the Chairman changed the order of business and called upon Mike Lipp and Dillon Lipp to address the Board. Dillon Lipp advised the Board he would be building a house 1 mile south in Mike Lipp's yard on the South Hingham branch line and wanted to hook onto the water line. Lowell Strissel advised the District was at capacity and would not be able to add any more connections at this time. Discussion took place on the Districts system failing and its inability to pump as much water as it used to. The Board advised new hookups would be allowed if the situation changes or upon the District connecting to the North Central Regional water line.

<u>PUBLIC COMMENTS</u>: Paul Wolery of Inverness, MT, Dillon Lipp, Mike Lipp and Ray Lipp of Hingham, MT, Charlie Smart and Amy Hackett of Kremlin, MT were present.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM PREVIOUS MEETINGS:

The Chairman asked for corrections or additions to the minutes of the April 9, 2024, regular board meeting previously received by all board members. On motion by Tina Wood, seconded by Rob Moog, the Board approved the minutes of the April 9, 2024, regular board meeting as presented.

PUBLIC HEARING: The Chairman declared the public hearing open for the purpose of gathering public comment on the Ordinance increasing fixed, variable and bulk rates.

Ray Lipp and Paul Wolery discussed the bulk rates and expressed opinions on graduated billing and billing of in town and out of town users.

Charlie Smart inquired about the fire hydrant in Kremlin, Montana that needed to be repaired and who to contact in Kremlin.

The Board reviewed the Ordinance Amending Sections 1.4 Water Charges and Section 1.5 Stand Pipe Charges. The Ordinance would increase the fixed, variable and bulk rates. The Ordinance was reviewed for its first reading and opened to the public for comment. No changes were made to the Ordinance.

Hearing no further questions or comments, the Chairman declared the public hearing closed and moved on to the Board's other agenda items.

NEW BUSINESS:

<u>EMPLOYEE REPORT</u>: Chad Hedges reported the cellular endpoints with incomplete readings have been replaced and all branch line meters are reading correctly.

Mr. Hedges advised the seal on pump 2 on the Joplin-Inverness pumps failed and new seals have been ordered. Mr. Hedges is also working on getting more production out of the Joplin-Inverness pumps 1 and 3.

Mr. Hedges also advised he is exercising valves at the river to try and improve flow.

Mr. Hedges reported Tammy Pike's pickup should arrive later in the week.

Mr. Hedges also reported the District had its first big call for water of 429,120 gallons in a day and the max flow the District could pump was 298 gpm without issues. With the District not being able to pump at higher gpms as it has in previous years, the District will struggle to provide enough water for its users from June through October. A Notice on conserving water will be provided to users to make them aware of the situation.

Mr. Hedges discussed purchasing new sensors for the Kuntze analyzers. The District may also be able to obtain sensors for the Kuntze analyzers for monitoring chloramines once the District connects to the North Central water line.

Mr. Hedges reported a leak was found on the East Kremlin branch line and repairs were being made.

<u>FINANCIAL REPORT</u>: Tammy Pike advised she did not have all the information for the 3rd quarter financial report. The report will be presented at the next regular meeting.

<u>CD RENEWAL</u>: Tammy Pike referred the Board to the Investment Report included with the meeting materials. She reported that a portion of the District's existing CD investments is subject to reinvestment in May. Ms. Pike reviewed with the Board CD investment options and quoted rates from banks noting that Independence Bank had the best rates. On motion by Rob Moog, seconded by Jason Myers, the Board approved renewing the existing CD at Independence Bank for one year at a rate of 4.41% and authorized the officers to execute any documents required.

ORDINANCE NO. 2024-1

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 1.4 WATER CHARGES AND 1.5 STAND PIPE CHARGES OF THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE HILL COUNTY WATER DISTRICT

BE IT ORDAINED by the Hill County Water District that:

Section 1.4 Water Charges of the Rules and Regulations of the Hill County Water District, is hereby amended to read as follows:

1.4 Water Charges:

Water rates for Hill County Water District users shall be as follows:

3/4", 5/8" & 1" residential - \$48 monthly plus \$3.00/1,000 gallon.

1½" residential & commercial - \$88 monthly plus \$3.00/1,000 gallon.

2" residential & commercial - \$168 monthly plus \$3.00/1,000 gallon.

3/4", 5/8" & 1" agricultural taps - \$48 monthly plus \$3.00/1,000 gallon, charged and payable only in months when actually used.

A user shall be defined as a household or business establishment which is connected to a Hill County Water District service line, whether or not water is used in the month of the charge, unless an exception within these rules relieves the user from a fee.

An ag tap user shall be defined as a hydrant/tap used for servicing livestock, gardens, trees and lawns and shall never be connected to any buildings.

Section 1.5 Stand Pipe Charges of the Rules and Regulations of the Hill County Water District, is hereby amended to read as follows:
